

How to reach Rome and INGV headquarters:

- **By plane**: Rome has 2 airports: Fiumicino "Leonardo Da Vinci" Airport (FCO) and Ciampino Airport (CIA).
 - FCO is an international airport and most of airlines land there.
 FCO has a fast train service (<u>Leonardo Express</u>) with direct connection to Termini central railways station every 15 minutes.
 - 2. Several bus services are available to connect CIA with Rome city centre.
- By taxi: Taxi service is available in both FCO and CIA airport. Fixed fare from FCO to Rome city centre is 50 EUR, from CIA to Rome city centre is 31 EUR
- **By train:** Rome has a central station "Termini", from which Metro Line B to LAURENTINA can be taken.
- **By Metro:** Metro Line B to the terminus <u>LAURENTINA</u> then take bus no. <u>765</u> in the direction of Arco di Travertino or the n. <u>702</u>, both with a stop in front of the Institute (last stop on via di Vigna Murata).
- By bus:
 - 1. line <u>766</u> from Trastevere Station, or 218 from P.za S. Giovanni in Laterano. Stop on via Ardeatina near the ex-Dazio.
 - 2. line 765 from Arco di Travertino.
